Dear Third Grade Parents,

I am reaching out to touch base about a few nursing related updates pertaining to this school year. As you may recall, hearing screenings were completed for the third graders. Letters were sent home at that time, but please contact me if you have any questions regarding this information. Also, heights and weights were measured earlier in the year, and your child's BMI (Body Mass Index) was calculated. I had planned to send these results home by mail because of the sensitivity of results (rather than home in folders); but given the circumstances, I prefer not to add to the circulation of physical mail at this time. If you have questions regarding your child's BMI results, please contact me via email. Vision screenings were also completed shortly before the abrupt closing of school. I apologize that I was not able to send letters or contact you with these results prior to that time. I will be contacting parents of students who may have struggled a bit with this screening very soon. If you have not heard from me by June 5, 2020; you can assume that your child has passed his or her vision screening. That being said, if your child is having vision related problems, please contact his or her doctor. This basic screening is not intended to replace a medical evaluation by a doctor if warranted. If you have specific questions, please feel free to email me!

Here's a break for you...there are no required dental or physical forms due upon entry into fourth grade! I do, of course, encourage you to maintain routine physical and dental well visits for your child once the current situation allows.
