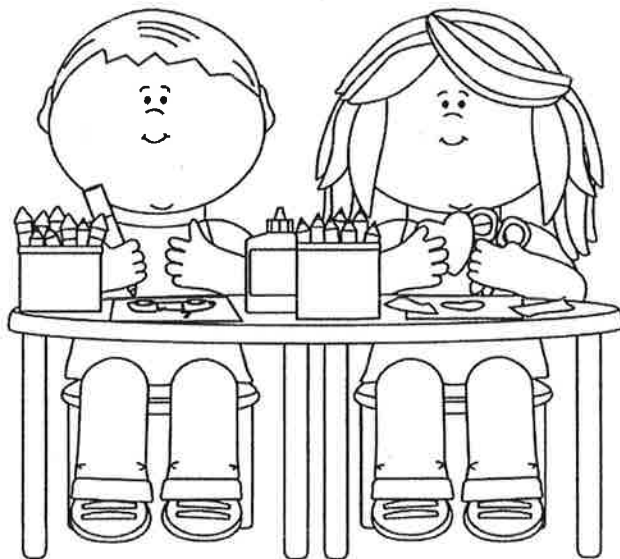

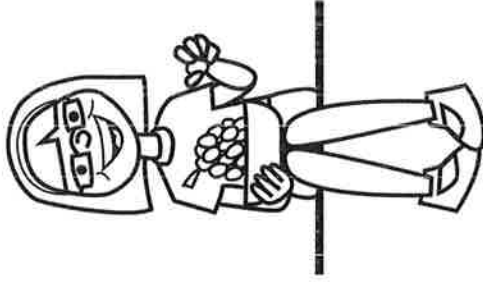

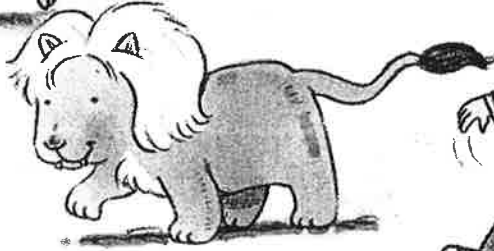
1. Circle back all the way around;
